Tommy Remengesau Jr., President of the Republic of Palau **Excellence in National Stewardship**

Palau's President Tommy Remengesau made a dramatic leap toward ocean sustainability by conceiving and signing into law legislation protecting 80 percent of his Pacific island nation's territorial waters from any extractive activities including fishing, drilling and mining—an area larger than California.
